**EX-PARTE TEMPORARY ORDER OF PROTECTION**

THIS MATTER having come before the COURT on a VERIFIED PETITION FOR ORDER OF PROTECTION and, the COURT being fully advised FINDS that an ORDER should issue. HEREBY ORDERS:

1. The PETITIONER and RESPONDENT shall appear before this COURT at the TORRANCE COUNTY COURTHOUSE, ESTANCIA, NEW MEXICO on the DATE and TIME as set out in the attached NOTICE OF HEARING.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED:

- The parties are prohibited from having any contact with one another pending the hearing.
- Respondent shall not go within 100 yards of Petitioner's place of residence.
- Respondent shall provide suitable temporary alternative housing for Petitioner and any children which the Respondent must legally support.
- Neither party shall transfer, conceal, encumber, or otherwise dispose of property, except in the usual course of business or for the necessities of life.
- A duly authorized law enforcement agency shall immediately evict the Respondent from the residence, and Respondent shall surrender all keys to that residence to Petitioner.
- Respondent may, in the presence of a law enforcement officer, remove necessary clothing and personal items from the residence at the time of eviction.
- The Respondent shall have no contact with the children who are presently in the custody of the Petitioner, until a court hearing.
- Neither party is to remove the children from the State of New Mexico pending the hearing.
