Supplemental Information for Question 23f

To Whom It May Concern:

On December 29, 1999 I called the police to my home because of a verbal dispute between my wife and me. There was no physical assault by any party. Nevertheless, the Bernalillo County Sheriff's office charged me with assault on a household member and with resisting, evading or obstructing an officer, one misdemeanor charge and the other a petty misdemeanor charge. I plead not guilty to both charges, because I was not guilty. When the District Attorney's office realized there was no evidence at all of the assault on a household member charge, the Assistant District Attorney moved to dismiss that charge with prejudice and the Court granted that order. Trial was then set only on the charge of resisting, evading or obstructing an officer but that charge was also dismissed before trial. There was never any trial, as both charges were dismissed.
