Re: Repeated Harassment by Sheriff's Department Personnel

December 27, 2007

Dear Darren White:

The purpose of this letter is to register a formal complaint regarding repeated harassment by your office's personnel. Since it is two days after Christmas and in the middle of the holidays, I include evidence of only the most recent harassment in this letter. However, you can be very sure that prior to January 10, 2008, I will follow up with evidence of the other incidents mentioned herein, along with a notice of tort claim as required by New Mexico state law.

Today, for the second time, I received the card copied on the following page from one of your employees, stuck in the front door of the home where I reside. Several weeks ago, your employee left a similar card, also provided on the following page. That one was taped to my front door. Otherwise, I have receive NOTHING from any court of law in this state explaining why your employees are at the doorstep of the home in which I reside. The first card was found by my thirteen-year-old son and it greatly frightened him. He called me in a panic after he arrived at home from school. The second card was found by contractors working on the home.

I have received no telephone calls and no letters explaining the behavior of your Deputy Carlos Gutierrez. These actions follow two egregious, previous actions on the part of your personnel, one during business hours inside of the Bernalillo County District Courthouse in which I was threatened with jail time for sitting at a table in an open, public place, and one in which one of your officers attempted to "investigate" me, stalking and interrogating multiple members of the organization over which I preside, the Center for Family Justice. Your employee impersonated a Sheriff's office investigator when he had no such role and we have discovered that he was doing a favor for Judge Deborah Davis Walker, mere days before she was to make a decision regarding a custody case in which he was the father. I have recorded conversations with your employees regarding the last two matters, along with sworn affidavits by multiple witnesses, including law enforcement personnel.

Enough is enough. I expect you to personally investigate this matter, and I expect legal documents to be produced to me by mail prior to your employees making any contact with me whatsoever. I am providing a notice of tort claim letter to you and State by

January 10 and if these situations are not fully investigated and resolved to my satisfaction, you can expect a lawsuit from me. For now, kindly back off your dogs and leave us alone. There is no justification for personally harassing my family during the holidays (or any other time, for that matter, without proper notice via a court of law).

If you have any questions at all about the veracity of my claim, perhaps you should review the new information posted at www.family-justice.org. Many members of your department are being implicated, and the American public will see to it that you never work in politics again. These actions simply add icing to the cake, and they will be made public. I hope I have made myself clear.
